### **New Water Bottle Filling Stations**

*The Mammoth Community Water District is excited to announce the installation of three water bottle filling stations along the Mammoth Lakes Trails System's multi-use path*

**Mammoth Lakes, California** – To support the goal of making our local water supply available to resident and visiting recreators, the Mammoth Community Water District is installing three water bottle filling and drinking fountain stations in high use areas on the multi-use path. The three locations include, near the Waterford bridge (complete), next to the Mammoth Creek Park bathroom (complete) and near the Twin Lakes Bridge (in progress). This project is a collaborative effort with the Town of Mammoth Lakes who will take over ownership and maintenance of the stations after installation.

“We are pleased to make our local water supply more available, reducing the need to purchase imported water bottles.” stated Mark Busby, General Manager. “After spending just ten minutes at the Waterford Bridge station, it is clear that the stations will get a lot of use and the community is very appreciative of this project.”
