Permit Administration Fees include plan checks, inspections and easement processing fees. For projects constructing over 1,000 feet of main line, fees will be calculated based on estimated staff hours for larger projects.

Permit Administration Fees include plan checks, inspections and easement processing. The minimum fee is a flat rate of \$200 for connections up to 39 fixture units. For connections between 40 and 1,775, the total calculation includes the \$200 application fee, in addition to \$1.33 per FU over 39. For connections with over 1,775 fixtures, the total calculation includes the \$200 application fee, in addition to \$2,300 plus \$0.34 per FU over 1,775.

Water and Wastewater Connection Fees

Each meter size has a corresponding number of allowable water fixture units and sewer equivalent units. Each new connection requiring a meter larger than 1" will pay a water connection fee of \$142.66 per water fixture unit. Each new connection requiring a meter larger than 2" will pay a sewer connection fee of \$108.33 per sewer equivalent unit. Please see the Allowable Water Fixture Units and Sewer Fixture Equivalents chart below.
